# Physical Education Requirement

- Document participation in a supervised after-school activity (e.g. scheduled time working with a trainer, dance or yoga instructor, etc.).

# Student Placement

- Teacher recommendations from sending school
- RZJHS Placement Test (Pre-ACT 8/9) and Hebrew Proficiency Test



# Daily Rhythm of School at RZJHS

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- School day begins at 8:40 a.m. (9:45 a.m. on Wednesdays)
- Day begins with first period, followed by Tefillah
- On Friday, school ends at 2:15 p.m. (Spring/Fall) and 1:15 p.m. (Winter)
- FPLA classes meet after lunch on Tuesdays and Thursdays
- Physical Education takes place after school



# Daily Rhythm of School at RZJHS

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- School days are structured around a modified block schedule (A-B-C days)
- Schedule allows for students to have built in study periods
- Schedule also allows for staggered homework schedule and project due dates.
- Not unlike the type of structure students may see in college
